25. The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 83.

26. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

27. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to parent/guardian.

28. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS Licence or superior (2NS is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the 2009 CAMS Manual.

29. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

30. The organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the event without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 59.

31. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

32. During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual.

In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

33. Any special requirement by the Club should be noted here.

The Judge of Fact will be the Senior Timekeeper for each test
