20. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:

Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the 2009 CAMS Manual are to be worn in **ALL** specials. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. All cars must be adequately muffled.

21. CLASSES:

Class A; 2WD, Wheelbase up to 2150mm
Class B: 2WD, Wheelbase 2151 to 2390mm
Class C: 2WD, Wheelbase 2391 to 2574mm
Class D: 2WD, Wheelbase 2575mm and over
Class E: 4WD vehicles, which must be driven in the four-wheel drive mode throughout the competition
Class F: Front-Wheel Drive Specials
Class G: Rear-Wheel Drive Specials

22. PRIZES AND TROPHIES:

1st Outright
1st in each Class (where 3 or more in class)
1st Lady
1st Junior

23. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

24. The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 83.

25. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

26. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.

27. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS Licence or superior. (2NS is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the 2009 CAMS Manual.

28. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

29. The organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the event without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 59.

30. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII the N.C.Rs.

31. During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.

32. Any special requirement by the Club should be noted here.

33. Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual
